

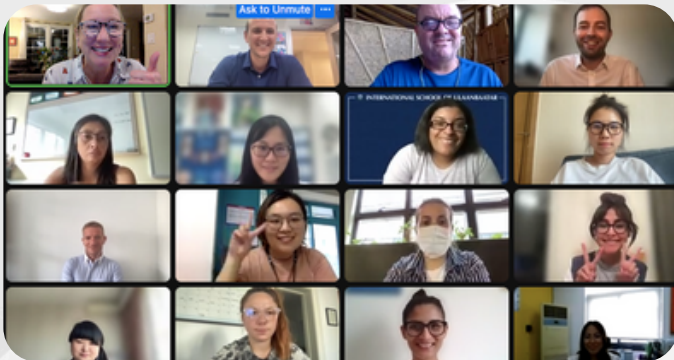
The PeerSphere Scholarship Programme
